**Subject:** Microsoft SQL 2005 Server (End of Support)

**Effective April 12, 2016** Microsoft is ending extended support of Microsoft SQL Server 2005 database management system. Security Hotfixes for Microsoft SQL Server 2005 will only be available via a Microsoft Custom Support Agreement at a cost of \$200,000 (up to 50 devices) per year. Important hotfixes will be available at a cost of \$50,000 per release. Agencies requiring custom support will receive pro-rated pass-through charges for all associated additional costs. The pro-rated charges will be calculated by using the percentage of the total number of devices requiring support. Security hotfixes will not be optional.

Additionally, there are still several Microsoft SQL Server 2000 databases in use posing a significant security risk to the Commonwealth network. This version has been obsolete since April 2013 and in the security interest of the Commonwealth, they must be upgraded without any further delay.

Agencies will need to support the resolution of application dependencies so that the migration to newer technology does not negatively affect applications. All database migrations for both versions should be completed by **Wednesday June 1, 2016**.
