



COT Security Alert – Site Blocks due to Malicious I-Frame

Recent reports from Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MSISAC) informs that a popular website (www.nbc.com) contains malicious code that, once visited, infects the user's machine with malware (Citadel and RedKit exploit kits). The infection then attempts to communicate with a malware command-and-control server/URL. In attempts to reduce the number of infections until this issue is resolved by the hosting company, we have blocked access to the NBC site and to all associated URLs. Once resolution is confirmed, the block on legitimate sites will be removed.
